## Board Member, Coach, Parent & Fan Code of Conduct

As representatives of ourselves, our community, and our sport, every family of any player participating in CYL MUST agree to the following code of conduct.

- I will treat all players, fans and opponents with respect and dignity.
- I will not verbally abuse any coach, player, fan or opponent.
- I will *never* attempt to talk with a referee, especially during game action.
- I will ask my child/player to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all coaches, players, fans and opponents.
- I will strive for improvements by positive reinforcement, not negative comments.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of all children/players before any personal desire to win by accepting both victory and defeat with pride and compassion.
- I will applaud all participants' efforts – win or lose.
- I will make it my responsibility to know, understand and appreciate the rules of the game.
- I will do my very best to make sure that youth sports are *fun*.
- I agree to allow the coaches be the ones providing instructions during practices and games.
- I will have the respect for the coaches and players to respectfully ask about situations that I may disagree with.
- I will have conversations with my family members in order to make sure that they understand the spirit of our efforts and behave accordingly at games and practices.
- I will agree that violating this Code of Ethics during a game may have consequences that could cause a parent or a coach to be ejected from that game by the referee. More than one violation could cause suspensions from future games.
